John 20:19-23

Today's Gospel reading from the Book of John tells us how on Sunday evening (the same day the women had been to the tomb of Jesus), the disciples were gathered in an upstairs room. They had locked the doors because they were afraid of the people who had crucified Jesus. Then Jesus came and stood in the room and said, "Peace be with you," and he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples were filled with joy when they saw the Lord. Jesus said again, "Peace be with you! As God has sent me to you, now I am sending you to others." Then he breathed on the disciples and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of anyone, they are forgiven. If you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

How do you think Jesus got into the room if the doors were locked? Why do you think Jesus said, "Peace be with you?" Is this phrase familiar to you? Where have you heard it? What does it mean to you? Why do you think that Jesus shows the disciples his hands and side?
