Mark 6:7-13

In today's Gospel Jesus sends the twelve apostles out in pairs and gives them authority over unclean spirits. He told them to take nothing with them except the clothes on their back and their sandals — no food, no sack, no money. They were to stay as guests wherever they were welcomed. And they were to leave any place where they were not welcomed — shaking the dust from their feet. So they went off and preached repentance, driving out many demons and curing the sick.

If guests like these came to your door, how would you treat them? Would you turn them away? Why or why not? How hard do you think it was for the apostles to leave with just the clothes on their back? Explain. How do you show Jesus that you welcome the message of repentance?
