Mark 6:30-34

Today's Gospel tells about the apostles meeting with Jesus and reporting all they had done and taught. Jesus said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." People were coming and going in huge numbers and the apostles had no time to eat. So, they went off in a boat by themselves to a deserted place. But, people saw them leaving and hurried on foot to get to the other side before they arrived in their boat. Jesus got out of the boat and saw the vast crowd; he was moved to pity for them, for they were like a sheep without a shepherd. So he began to teach them many things. Jesus sees that the apostles are tired, and he wants them to take time for themselves and rest.

When you are tired and have had a hard day, do you find rest in Jesus? How? This reading tells us how Jesus sees a spiritual hunger in the people. What do you do when you want more information about your faith? Whom do you go to for answers?
