A grief recovery Weekend is being offered by Beginning Experience July 24 - 26, 2009. The retreat consists of presentations by Beginning Experience team members, periods for private personal reflection and sharing in small groups.

Two nights lodging in a double room, meals and resource materials are included in the cost of \$195. However, partial scholarships and special payment arrangements are available.

The retreat will be held at The Griffin Center in Milwaukee, near Clackamas Town Center. Follow-up sessions will be held in Eugene, Portland, and Salem.
