**John 3:14-21**

In today's reading from the Gospel of John, we hear Jesus telling Nicodemus, who is a Pharisee, that the "Son of Man" (Jesus) must be lifted up so that all who believe in Jesus will have eternal life. Jesus says God loves us so much that He gave us Jesus — and that if we believe in Him, we will be saved. Jesus, who is the light, came into the world. Those who do evil work, hate the light, and do not come toward it. But those who live the truth, come to Jesus, and their actions are reflections of God.

*God's love for us is huge! How can you respond to such love? What can you do to show God your thanks for his great gift?*
