John 12:20-33

In today's Gospel, Jesus talks about resurrection. "I tell you that a grain of wheat that falls on the ground will never be more than one grain unless it dies. But if it dies, it will produce lots of wheat." These words are at the heart of our Faith. The grain of wheat is Jesus, himself, and it is His death on a cross that produces the "fruit" of everlasting life.

Think about someone that you think is unselfish. How have they made others happy by being unselfishness? What do you tend to "hold on to" rather than follow Jesus? (What do you need "to die to" or "let go of" to better follow Jesus?)
