**March 8, 2009**

**Mark 9:2-10**

In today's Gospel reading, Mark tells us that Jesus led Peter, James and John up a high mountain. While there, Jesus was transfigured and appeared with Moses and Elijah. Peter, being nervous and wanting to please Jesus, offered to make three tents – one for each of them. Suddenly, they heard the voice of God proclaiming, "This is my beloved son. Listen to Him." When this was all done and the four were heading back down the mountain, Jesus made them promise not to tell anyone what had happened until he had risen from the dead.

*What do you think the word "transfigured" means? If you were one of the disciples and saw this, what would your reaction be? Do you think it was easy for the disciples to keep this secret? Why or why not? Can you keep a secret when asked to?*
