John 10:11-18

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus said, "I am the good shepherd" and then goes on to tell how a good shepherd will lay down his life to protect his sheep. A man who is hired to look after the flock is not a shepherd and does not own the sheep, and he will run away and leave the sheep if a wolf attacks the flock. The hired man works for money and will not risk his life for something that does not belong to him. Jesus then says, "I am the good shepherd, and I know my sheep and my sheep know me, just like my Father knows me and I know my Father. I will give up my life for my sheep. I have other sheep that are not here but I must gather them and bring them together. They will hear my voice and come. Then there will be one flock, one shepherd."

Think about someone whom you think is unselfish. How have they made others happy by being unselfish? What do you tend to "hold on to" rather than follow Jesus? (What do you need "to die to" or "let go of" to better follow Jesus?)
