Matthew 5:1-12a

Today is the great feast day of All Saints. In the Gospel reading, we hear how Jesus gathers His followers around him on a hillside and teaches them a recipe or a formula for being a good person. Jesus gives His followers the Beatitudes — a recipe or formula for our hearts and our minds.

One of the Beatitudes says: "Blessed are the merciful." What does it mean to be merciful? Can you think of a time when you were merciful to someone? Another of the Beatitudes says: "Blessed are the peacemakers." Talk about some people you know who are peacemakers. What do they do? How do they do it? What can you do to thank someone who is a peacemaker? Say the Our Father with your family or some friends and pray for peace in our world.

TOBIN LECTURE

The Office of Justice and Peace/Respect Life offers the annual Tobin Lecture in honor of the memory of Msgr. Thomas Tobin who dedicated his life's work to struggles for social justice and liturgical renewal. It takes place Saturday, November 14, at All Saints Church (3847 NE Glisan) in Portland and lasts from 9:00 a.m. to noon.

Respect Life is the theme of this year's Tobin Lecture with a focus on issues that highlight respecting life and the dignity of the human person: death penalty, abortion, immigration and human trafficking.
